Chairperson Vanderspek recognized Commissioner McCallum requested a clarification on the block codes. The City Clerk explained that those codes are for the proposed locations.

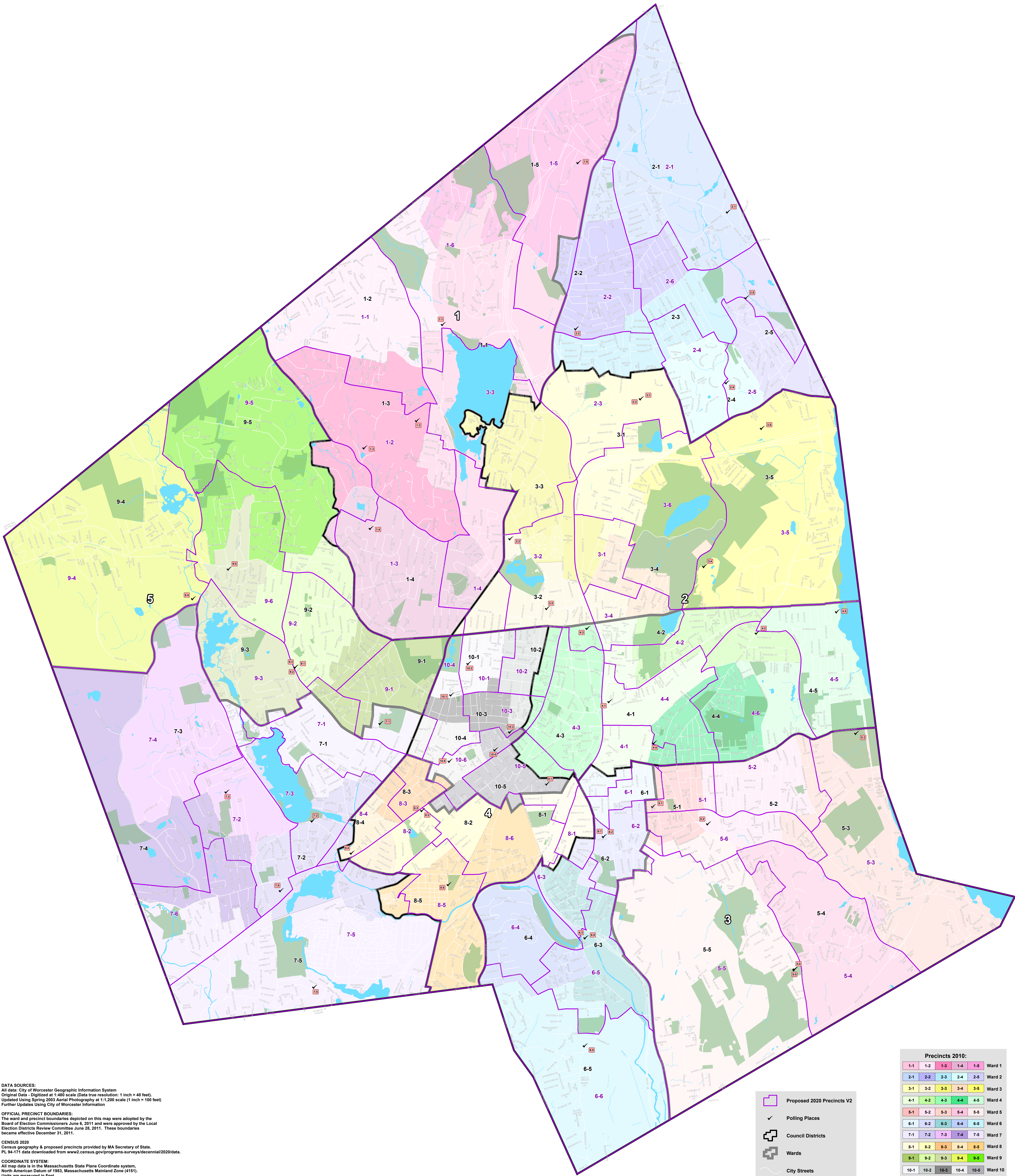
The Commissioners also requested more advertisement for the Census 2020 redistricting commission meetings.

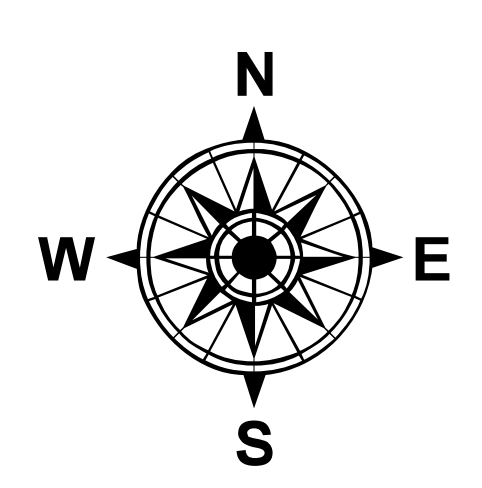
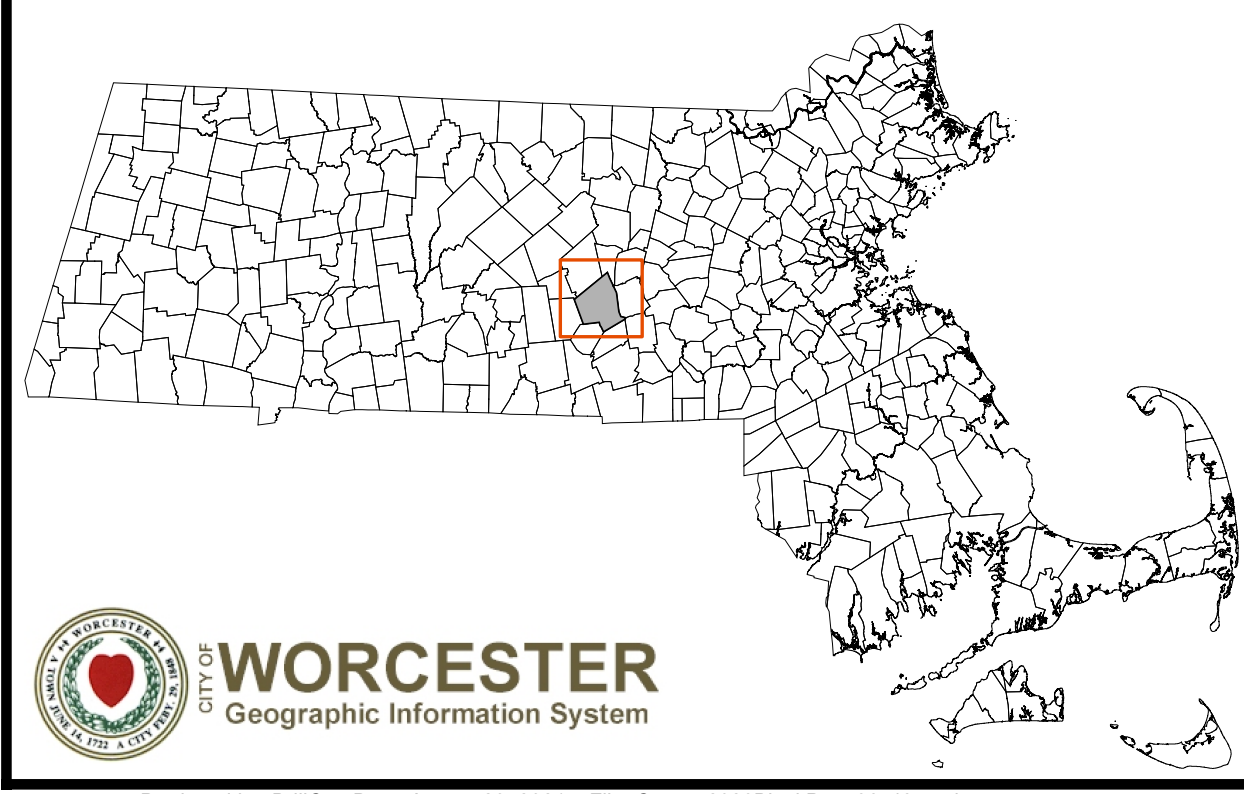

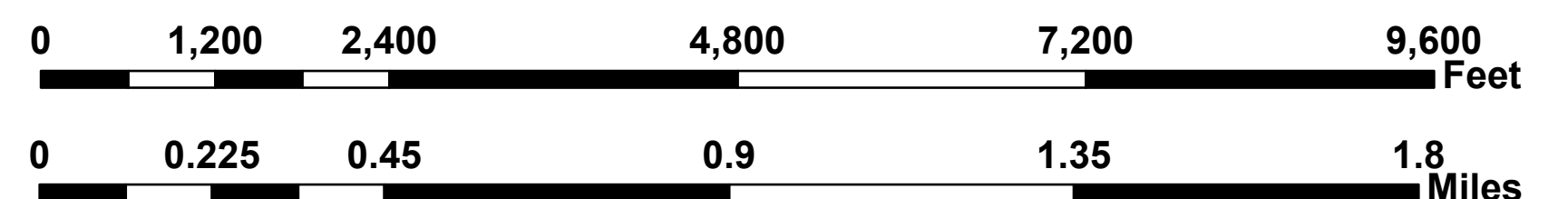

Census 2020 Proposed Precincts V2

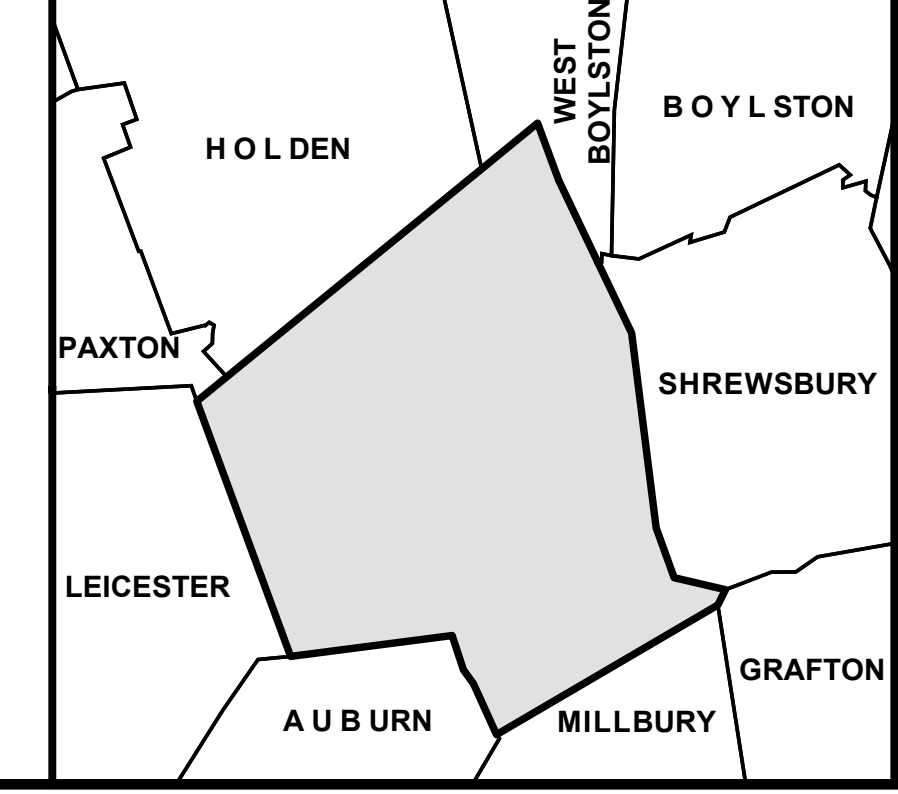

Guide to Reading Redistricting Spreadsheet:

The Redistricting spreadsheet is two sheets with a tab for each at the bottom.

The first tab (All Precincts) is all information for all precincts in the city. The second tab (District Ward Summary 9_27_21) summarizes by District and Ward.

All Precincts sheet:

This sheet is organized by Districts, Wards, and Precincts by rows.

At the bottom of each Ward section, there is a breakdown by Ward. At the end, there is a total city summary.

COLUMNS:

District and Precinct: Self Explanatory

Precinct Population: The population of the precincts per the 9/24 modifications.

Target Precinct Population: This is the same for every precinct in the city. The population of all precincts should be within $\pm 5\%$ of the target number. This number is calculated as:

$$\text{Target Population} = \frac{\text{Total City Population}}{\text{Total Number of Precincts}} = \frac{206518}{60}$$

Deviation: The Deviation is the *number* of residents in the precinct above or below (indicated with a negative sign) the Target Precinct Population.

% Deviation: The Percent Deviation is the *percentage* of residents in the precinct above or below (indicated with a negative sign) the Target Precinct Population.

White: The number of White residents in the precinct.

% White: The percentage of White residents in the precinct.

$$\% \text{ White} = \frac{\text{White}}{\text{Precinct Population}}$$

% Minority: The percentage of Minority residents in the precinct.

$$\% \text{ Minority} = \frac{\text{Precinct Population} - \text{White}}{\text{Precinct Population}}$$

The rest of the columns have the percentage of smaller ethnic groups. The number of people in each group is hidden, but still there. The columns were hidden for readability and so that the printed spreadsheet would fit on a single landscape page.

Black: The number of Black residents in the precinct.

% Black: The percentage of Black residents in the precinct.

$$\% \text{ Black} = \frac{\text{Black}}{\text{Precinct Population}}$$

Hispanic: The number of Hispanic residents in the precinct.

% Hispanic: The percentage of Hispanic residents in the precinct.

$$\% \text{ Hispanic} = \frac{\text{Hispanic}}{\text{Precinct Population}}$$

Similarly, the rest of the columns are the percentage of other ethnic groups. The number of people in those groups are hidden so that the document is readable and can be contained to one landscape page. You can unhide the columns in the spreadsheet file if you want to see them.
