## **Board of Election, Commissioners' Meeting Minutes**

**Date: 8/9/23**

**Meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm**

**Pledge of Alliance was said.**

**First Business Item: City Clerk reviewed program of upcoming process of City and state elections with the Human Rights Commission. The overarching goal of the Human Rights Commission is to address low voter turnout and how better to partner with the Election Commission. City Clerk reviewed specifics of both City Councilor and Mayoral race as well as School Committee race – including candidates, preliminaries, early voting, updates on vote by mail ballot requests (approx. 6,800), School Committee redistricting and election calendar. Voting process remains largely unchanged – All candidates will be on one ballot – voter arrives – voter checks in - states name and address to be checked against the voter roll list – given a ballot – votes tabulated in machine. Election Commissioners expressed concern that no documents for proof of identity were needed and City Clerk indicated that the system confirms the validity of the information**

**Second Business Item: Perparation of Sept 5<sup>th</sup> Muncipal preliminary. Over 6,800 mail in ballots requests to date. Online poll worker training portal to go live in one week. Commission voted for Early ballot counting to be done on Sat Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8 am o 5 pm – with the option to carry over to Sun Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> if needed.**

**Third Business Item: Details to follow concerning all upcoming elections – Oct 10<sup>th</sup>, Nov 7<sup>th</sup>, Special State Election Worcester and Hampshire District at next meeting date.**

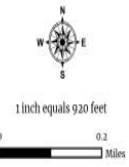
