The City of Worcester is holding an informational meeting on **Wednesday**, **February 1**, **2023**. The meeting is to assist in the development of upcoming community focus groups that will be happening in April. The sessions are to help gather information regarding the Spectrum-Charter franchise in Worcester. Spectrum-Charter is one of only a handful of companies whose services touch almost every city resident, and the only one which is required under Federal law to have a franchise agreement with the City.

We hope you can attend one of the informational meetings on Wednesday, February 1st:

The upcoming focus groups will seek input from all segments of the community who have an interest in or are users of cable communication services. The City of Worcester is seeking to determine what community programming and cable service obligations should be included in a new agreement. A major component of the franchise renewal process is a *Community Needs Assessment*. Information gathered from a broad representation of residents and agencies will help future public, educational and government access TV resources, community and educational benefits, and other cable Television related services to be provided by Spectrum-Charter.

At the informational meeting on February 1, 2023, we will describe how you and your organization can benefit from the outcomes of a renewed franchise. The City has retained Sue Buske of The Buske Group consulting firm to lead the meeting, facilitate the upcoming focus groups, conduct the community needs assessment process, and prepare a report of findings and recommendations. The participants in this informational meeting will include people like you and other community leaders who live or work here and can assist the City by:

- Identifying participants who could provide input at the focus group meetings to be held April.
- Encouraging attendance at the focus group meetings through follow-up contacts.
