Amy reviewed and the committee discussed the following: While the State COA contract has not arrived yet, we are assured of \$9.70/elder for the formula grant; a revised budget was reviewed which reflects the COA reduction; The instability and our heavy reliance on the Senior Aide program was discussed and will be brought to the attention of the City Manager; The third floor is currently filled with tenants as planned; and the status of the parking lot currently being advertised for sale with the Anderson building by St. Vincent Hospital should be clarified soon with the need to use the parking lot for the Senior Center paramount.

Operations:

Patty reported on and the committee discussed the following: Staffing issues include the loss of one receptionist senior aide, the transportation monitor being out sick, and the delay in hiring the Chinese Elder Group Coordinator; Building services is status quo with the grounds work wrapping up; the Veterans event and Sheriff's Symposium both went well; Upcoming events include Know Your City, Thanksgiving, Craft Fair, Manhattan Film Festival and many holiday events; and students remain plentiful.

Suggestions were made for future speakers at Commission meetings. The Age/Dementia Friendly initiative was also discussed briefly.
