
CHANDLER STREET REDESIGN





PROJECT OVERVIEW

Creating a safer place to live, visit, and do business.

The City of Worcester, in partnership with the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT), has undertaken a project to study and redesign Chandler Street (Route 122) between Main Street and Park Avenue. Today, Chandler Street sees a combination of high speeds mixed with congested intersections, frequent vehicular crashes, and a lack of modern accommodations for those biking, using micromobility, taking transit, or walking, all of which was underscored by attendees at a public meeting held for this project in Summer 2021. This project aims to make the Chandler Street corridor a safer and more inviting place to live, visit, travel, and do business.

Based on what we have learned from community input and technical analysis, the project team proposes a redesign of Chandler Street that helps lower vehicle speeds, reduce pedestrian crossing distances, and generally improve safety for all users. While a two-way left turning lane will help maintain mobility for private vehicles, delivery trucks, and WRTA buses, repurposing a travel lane and parking spaces allows the introduction of:

- · Safety improvements, such as fully protected intersections, shortened crossings, and median refuges for pedestrians
- Dedicated and protected bike and micro-mobility infrastructure
- Improved bus stops equipped with shelters and amenities
- Modern streetscape, including green storm water management, to help create a sense of place on Chandler Street
