Re: Sale to a Person Under Minimum Legal Sales Age-1st Violation

Dear Owner,

On June 27, 2023, the Worcester Division of Public Health (WDPH) conducted youth tobacco compliance check throughout the city of Worcester, including at the business located at **256 Park Avenue, Worcester, MA** (the "store"), resulting in violations of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 270 Section 6, relative to sales to minors. During the inspection, Cherry Tangri, WDPH Tobacco Inspector witnessed the sale of a flavored nicotine product (crave 5% guava ice) to a minor. The owner was notified of such violation after the sale.

M.G.L Chapter 270. Section 6(b) prohibits the sale of tobacco products to a person under the age of 21. Tobacco retailers are required to verify the age of a purchaser by means of a valid government-issued photographic identification, as set forth in the Department of Public Health'[s regulations at 105 CMR665.000 related to Minimum Standards for Retail Sale of Tobacco. ¹

Accordingly, you are hereby notified of the violation of MGL Chapter 270, § 6(b) relevant to the sale of tobacco to a person under the age of twenty-one (21). Enclosed find a ticket in the amount of \$1,000.00² that must be paid to the City of Worcester clerk within 21 days of date of this notice.

You will be notified by the Board of Health regarding a hearing date related to the violation of the Store's City of Worcester Tobacco Permit. The Board of Health has the right to suspend the tobacco permit for a period of up to 30 consecutive days.

¹ Section 665.020: Identification Requirements

⁽A) Unless otherwise specified in 105 CMR 665.000, each person selling or providing tobacco products shall verify the age of the purchaser by means of a valid government-issued photographic identification containing the bearer's date of birth that the purchaser is 21 years of age or older, as verified by said person's proof of identification.

² MGL Chapter 270, § 6(d)"A person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of \$1,000 for the first offense, \$2,000 for a second offense and \$5,000 for a third or subsequent offense", as codified in the Worcester Board of Health Regulations – Section H, "Violations"

Please be advised that any additional violations will result in additional fines stated above. Periodic, unannounced inspections will occur.

Re: Sale to a Person Under Minimum Legal Sales Age- 1st Violation

Dear Owner,

On June 27, 2023, the Worcester Division of Public Health ("WDPH") conducted a youth tobacco compliance check at the business located at **256 Park Avenue**, **Worcester**, **MA** (the "Store"), resulting in a violation of state and local law related to sales of tobacco to a minor.¹ During the compliance check a WDPH Tobacco Inspector witnessed an employee of the Store make a sale of flavored tobacco product to a minor.²

Accordingly, the Board of Health voted on warning for the tobacco permit suspension for your establishment in the board of health meeting on October 2, 2023.

¹ Worcester General Revised Ordinances, Chapter 8, Section 3(c), Tobacco Sales to Persons Under the Minimum Legal Sales Age prohibited: (1) No retailer shall sell, or attempt to sell, or otherwise attempt to distribute a tobacco product to a minor; Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 270, Section 6(d), relative to sales to minors: "A person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of \$1,000 for the first offense, \$2,000 for a second offense and \$5,000 for a third or subsequent offense."

² Worcester General Revised Ordinances, Chapter 8, Section(c): (6) Identification: Each Retailer selling or distributing tobacco products shall verify the age of the purchaser by means of valid government-issued photographic identification showing the purchaser is not a minor. Verification is required for any person under the age of twenty-seven.

Re: Sale of Flavored Tobacco 2nd Violation

Dear Owner,

On February 9, 2024, an execution of search warrant was conducted at your business located at **256 Park Avenue, Worcester, MA** (the "store"), resulting in violations of *Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 270 Section 6, relative to sale of flavored tobacco products.* This investigation was conducted by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Attorney General's Office, Worcester Police Department (WPD), Department of Revenue (DOR), and the Worcester Division of Public Health (WDPH). An inspection of the store resulted in recovering numerous flavored tobacco products including cigars, blunt wraps, vape products, and Delta 8/ THC vape products behind the counter. The ongoing criminal investigation may result in charges against you, Mousa Bcharah, the owner.

M.G.L Chapter 270, Section 6, and the Board of Health Regulation related to Restricting the sale of Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems and Flavored Tobacco Products adopted in 2020, prohibit the sale of flavored tobacco and electronic nicotine delivery systems.¹

Accordingly, you are hereby notified of the aforementioned violations relevant to sale of flavored tobacco products. Enclosed find a ticket in the amount of 2000^2 that must be paid to the City of Worcester within 21 days of the date of this notice. Please deliver payment to: Worcester City Clerk, 455 Main Street, Worcester MA 01608.

Additionally, you are hereby notified that the Board of Health will hold a public hearing related to the violation on Monday, March 18, 2024 at 6:30 PM in room 109, 1st floor, 25

¹105 CMR 665.010, Section "(D) No person shall sell, distribute cause to be sold or distributed, or offer for sale to a consumer located in the Commonwealth a flavored tobacco product or tobacco product enhancer, except for a smoking bar for on-site consumption..."

² MGL Chapter 270, § 6(d)"A person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of \$1,000 for the first offense, \$2,000 for a second offense and \$5,000 for a third or subsequent offense", as codified in the Worcester Board of Health Regulations – Section H, "Violations."
