Proposed new License Commission rule:

When providing bottle service a licensed establishment must provide a “bottle host” who is responsible for handling the alcohol at all times. A “bottle host” is defined as an employee of the licensed liquor establishment, who is TIPS certified, and that handles the alcohol for a specific table. A bottle host may not leave alcohol unattended at any time.
