The City of Worcester is seeking proposals from qualified organizations to undertake prioritized, targeted community development activities and quality of life, safety net program services under Worcester's annual Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids (HOPWA) programs. Eligible activities for funding include a wide range of programs that address priority needs identified in Worcester's Annual Community Development Action Plan (7/1/12 – 6/30/13). Any proposed project or program must primarily benefit low to moderate income residents of Worcester and be consistent with the goals and objectives of the Action Plan.
