### APPLICATION ASSISTANCE:

#### 9:00AM—10 AM: WRTA Reduced Fare ID for people with disabilities & seniors

**BRING:**

**2 forms of identification (1 with photo/DOB ) & \$3.00 cash**

Benefits of WRTA Reduced Fare ID for Seniors and People with Disabilities:

- If you're 60 years of age or older or have a disability, you can ride the bus for half the regular fare with proper identification
- Valid on all WRTA buses and other MA Transit Authorities
- Ride half fare

#### 10AM—11:30 AM: MBTA Blind Access & Senior Charlie Cards

**BRING:**

**For a MBTA Blind Charlie Card bring your Certificate of Blindness  
For a Senior Charlie Card bring one ID with photo and DOB (Examples: Mass. ID, License, Passport)**

Benefits of MBTA Blind Access and Senior Charlie Cards

- Valid on all Mass. RTAs that use Charlie Card System
- Blind— No fare charge
- Senior Card—Reduced fare
