LP GAS INSTALL / CONNECT PERMIT APPLICATION

Application for a permit to Connect or Install Liquid Propane Gas Storage equipment shall be made in the name of the owner or occupant of the premises by the person, firm or corporation who will make the installation or connection to permanent fixtures. The Worcester Fire Department may limit the quantity of LP-Gas that may be stored under a permit, such as during special events, where unusual conditions exist. Additional requirements may be included that are within the intent and purpose of **527 CMR 69**

Procedures:

Permanent

1. Applicant applies for permit (print an application attached). Application must have a descriptive site plan that shows location of tank, proximity to property lines, structures, doors, windows and other sources of ignition.
2. Permit Fee - \$50.00 check or money order payable to: City of Worcester.
3. Inspection by The Worcester Fire Department within 7-10 days.
4. Propane Storage Permit may be required. Tank should not be filled until permits are granted and inspected by the Fire Department.

Permit is valid for 1 year for non-residential. Restrictions may apply.



Application to Install/Connect Propane

In accordance with 527 CMR 69, Board of Fire Prevention, & Departmental regulations.
Commercial or industrial indoor tanks must be steel & caged.
