First Business Item:

Preparation for Sept. 6th State Primary: Clare said they are looking for poll workers; anyone interested should contact the elections; Early voting 8/27-9/2/22; Primary 9/6/22.

Clare said that there is a lawsuit pending to challenge the new voting law. The clerk's office will keep us posted on any developments.

Request for Early Voting; application mailed by Sec of State 45 days before the election; votersnmust complete application; elections will mail ballots, which must be returned by 8 pm on election day.

Early voting to occur from Saturday, August 27th to Friday, September 2nd.

Early ballots may be opened and deposited before election day.

No campaigning within 150 feet of the earl; y voting locations is now part of the new law.

Second Business Item:

Early Voting Locations Approved by the Commission by 4-0 vote.

Third Business Item:

Count Mail in ballots on 9/6 and 11/8 at Levi Lincvoln Chamber City Hall Need another 150-200 poll workers for primary and election day.
