First Business Item: November 8th State elections. Review of Primary: Approx 16.5% participation. Approx 7K mail in ballots and 11 K in-person voting. IPads aided in alleviating confusion with new voting locations. All voters in Worcester to receive cards for mail in voting ballots in Worcester

Second Business Item: Commission approval of attached Early voting locations and scheduled – 14 days leading u to elections including two weekends and Tuesday and Thursday 7 pm extended hours.

Third Business Item: Poll workers needed in 62 locations. Plan to utilize volunteers from primaries. Holes and vacancies are in need of being filled. Plan is to recruit from Worcester Public High Schools – as 16 years + can work

Fourth Business Item: Proposal of Early voter tabulation at Levi Lincoln Hall. Expecting 25-30k responses with 2 cards equaling 50-60k cards.
