A Senior Services presentation was made by Linda and Yung, talking about their Senior Services responsibilities: information & referral, advocacy & outreach, assistance with applications & access to resources, evidence based programs, multicultural and intergenerational programs. Commission members asked clarifying questions and commended them for their work.

Amy reviewed the status of the goals and objectives: The full FY'17 state COA grant funding is now transferred to the city account; The Retired Men's Club of Greendale was thanked for their donation to the Friends, Inc; An assistive technology center is being integrated into the computer lab; Quinsigamond Community College is expanding their offerings to include a congregate dinner one night a week as well as a weekly "take home meal; " A substance abuse conference will be held on May 23<sup>rd</sup> organized by the Elder Abuse Roundtable and partial funding will come from Elder Affairs; Elder Affairs staff was recognized for their teamwork, receiving the City's annual Eleanor Rik award; The participant satisfaction survey is available for those who wish to respond; Family Services and Quinsigamond Community College leases have been amended to switch one office; and she mentioned various publicity received cooperative efforts with other organizations.

Patty reported on: holiday events and various programs; the Know Your City series has been interesting and well attended; and concerning the physical building status, the renovations for the new clinic and arts and crafts room will begin in March.

Linda reported on outreach efforts for the month and Saideh reported on her activities for the month.

Elizabeth made some announcements including making successful referrals from the Vietnamese community to the Senior Center. There was discussion about marketing efforts and what could happen in the future.
