Amendment to Off-Premises liquor license to add rule:

Managers of all licensed liquor establishments shall be responsible for all violations or infractions of the law occurring on the premises whether present or not. The licensee is responsible for any disorder, disturbance or illegality of any kind taking place on license premises whether present or not.

Amendment to On-Premises and Off-Premises liquor license to add rule:

In the event that a disturbance or breach of the peace occurs on the licensed premises resulting in physical injury to any person (s), the Licensee or responsible person shall promptly notify the police and shall take all reasonable steps to assist such injured persons and shall cooperate with police in their investigation.
