Other Business

1. Outdoor Dining Regulations – Update on temporary program and potential longer term actions

Mr. Rolle reviewed the status of the program from last year and suggested that the permits be extending another year.

Commissioners Haller and Vigliotti expressed concern that since last year there are more people out and more traffic so not sure they would want to blanket approve all the licenses and suggested maybe reviewing all the applications again or in lieu of that reviewing establishments that lose significant parking by adding the temporary outdoor area and what effects the temporary dining may have on noise level in the neighborhoods.

Mr. Rolle suggested that the item be postponed and staff would look into those matters.

Upon a roll call the Commission voted 3-0 to postpone the item to the April 1, 2021 License Commission meeting.

2. On-premises Liquor License Renewal Fees for Calendar Year 2021
