INFORMATIONAL COMMUNICATION **REGARDING WPI'S PURCHASE OF HOTELS**

ITEM 9.39 A: TRANSMITTING INFORMATIONAL **COMMUNICATION RELATIVE TO** WORCESTER POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE'S **PURCHASING OF HAMPTON INN & SUITES AT 65 PRESCOTT ST. AND COURTYARD MARRIOTT AT 72 GROVE ST.**

MAYOR PETTY FIRST REQUESTED THAT THE CITY MANAGER CONSIDER POTENTIAL PARTNERSHIPS BETWEEN WPI AND THE WORCESTER PUBLIC SCHOOLS, FUTURE INVESTMENTS WPI COULD MAKE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY, THE IMPACT OF LOSING TWO HOTELS ON THE CITY'S CAPACITY TO ACCOMMODATE VISITORS, AND THE POTENTIAL EFFECTS OF THE WAGE THEFT ORDINANCE IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH WPI.

COUNCILOR MERO-CARLSON FOLLOWED BY ASKING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENSURE THAT TAXATION NUMBERS ASSOCIATED WITH WPI'S RECENT PROPERTY PURCHASES AT 65 PRESCOTT ST. AND 72 GROVE ST. ACCURATELY REFLECT THEIR POST-PURCHASE VALUES. COUNCILOR BERGMAN THEN CALLED FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE A REPORT ON HOW THE CITY COULD PROTECT ITSELF FROM MORE PROPERTIES BEING TAKEN OFF THE TAX ROLLS BY COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES. COUNCILOR TOOMEY ASKED THE CITY MANAGER TO REVIEW HOW THE DOVER AMENDMENT APPLIES TO RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY.

COUNCILOR KING ADDED A MOTION, URGING THE CITY MANAGER TO MOVE FORWARD WITH CREATING A TASK FORCE TO ASSIST WITH PAYMENTS IN LIEU OF TAXES (PILOTS). THROUGHOUT THE DISCUSSION, COUNCILORS RUSSELL, COLORIO, AND HAXHIAJ SHARED THEIR PERSPECTIVES. THE CITY MANAGER AND CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER ADDRESSED QUESTIONS POSED BY COUNCILOR KING, AND COUNCILOR OJEDA ALSO SPOKE ON THE ISSUE, FOLLOWED BY THE CITY MANAGER RESPONDING TO HIS INQUIRIES.

THE ITEM WAS ULTIMATELY REFERRED TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE AFTER A ROLL CALL VOTE OF 11 YEAS AND 0 NAYS.

THE WORCESTER REGIONAL RESEARCH BUREAU (WRRB) HAS SUBMITTED TWO KEY RESOURCES FOR THE CITY COUNCIL'S CONSIDERATION: A REPORT TITLED *BUILDING THE FUTURE: INVESTING IN WORCESTER PUBLIC SCHOOLS FACILITIES*, WHICH OUTLINES THE CONDITION OF WPS FACILITIES AND THE EFFORTS TO IMPROVE THEM, AND AN INTERACTIVE DASHBOARD THAT PROVIDES SCHOOL PROFILES AND DEMOGRAPHIC DATA. THE WRRB REQUESTS THAT THESE RESOURCES BE ENTERED INTO THE PUBLIC RECORD AND IS AVAILABLE TO PRESENT FINDINGS OR BRIEF THE CITY COUNCIL AND ITS COMMITTEES

ITEM 14A: REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SAFETY **UPON THE COMMUNICATION OF THE CITY** MANAGER TRANSMITTING INFORMATIONAL **COMMUNICATION RELATIVE TO THE CITY'S** TRANSITION FROM SMART911 TO RAPIDSOS: RECOMMEND COMMUNICATION BE PLACED ON

THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS AND MANAGEMENT WILL TRANSITION FROM SMART911 TO RAPIDSOS ON OCTOBER 1, 2024, TO IMPROVE DATA COLLECTION AND RESPONSE DURING EMERGENCIES. THIS NEW SYSTEM OFFERS REAL-TIME LOCATION TRACKING AND HEALTH PROFILES, ACCESSIBLE THROUGH A FREE RAPIDSOS PROFILE OR APPLE'S MEDICAL ID ON IPHONES. THE CHANGE AIMS TO ENHANCE THE EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF EMERGENCY RESPONSES BY PROVIDING TELECOMMUNICATORS WITH BETTER INFORMATION AND TOOLS.
