FAQs:

Q: What is the Municipal Election?

A: The Municipal Election elects the Mayor, At-Large City Councilors, District City Councilors, At-Large School Committee Members, and District School Committee members.

Q: Is there a Municipal Preliminary?

A: Municipal Preliminaries are only necessary if there are more than two candidates running for the same district seat. The Preliminary would take place on September 2nd.

Q: Who can vote in the Municipal Election?

A: Any registered voter in the City can vote.

Q: Do I need an excuse to vote by mail? (If yes, what is a valid excuse?)

A: You do not need an excuse.

Q: Do I automatically get sent a mail-in ballot?

A: No, you must register to vote by mail. You can register online, by mail or through email or fax.

Q:When do I need to return my ballot?

All ballots must be returned by close of polls on Election Day (8 p.m.)

Tuesday, March 4th, 8:45 am- First day & hour to access nomination papers @ the offices of the Board of Election Commissioners, Room 208, City Hall.

Tuesday, May 6th, 5:00 pm– Last day & hour for submitting nomination papers to the Board of Election Commissioners for certification of signatures.

Thursday, May 15th, 5:00 pm- Last day & hour to file a withdrawal or objections to nomination of candidates with the Board of Election Commissioners.

Saturday, August 23rd- Last day & hour to register to vote in the Preliminary Election. Office Hours 8 AM – 5 PM

Tuesday, Sept. 2nd- Preliminary Election, Polls are open 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. (if necessary, Worcester Charter Section 7-4f)

Tuesday, Sept. 9th- Last day & hour to decline nomination for election to Mayor, Council, or School Committee and for submitting non-binding public opinion advisory questions for certification of signatures.

Saturday, October 25th- Last day & hour to register to vote in the Municipal Election. Office Hours 8 AM - 5 PM

Tuesday, Nov. 4th- Municipal Election, Polls are open 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.
