



DUMPSTER PERMIT APPLICATION

(PERMANENT/TEMPORARY)

The permit application requires the requesting contractor or property owner to identify their name and address and the address of where the dumpster will be located. In accordance with [527 CMR 1.0-1.12.8.5](#), containers shall not be placed at any location as to become an obstacle to the egress of persons from a building or to vehicle traffic. Any dumpster 6 yards or more needs a permit. A permit is not required for dumpsters that will be delivered and removed from a location on the same business day. Permit is valid for one (1) year from date of issue; permanent dumpster permits are renewable annually.

Procedure:

1. Dumpster contractor or customer applies for permit (via OpenGov portal).
2. Permit fee — \$25.00 per container and \$10.00 for each additional container on a particular site. Payments can be made through OpenGov.

Dumpster location on private property to be inspected by the Worcester Fire Department.
