



DUMPSTER PERMIT APPLICATION (PERMANENT/TEMPORARY)

The permit application requires the requesting contractor or property owner to identify their name and address and the address of where the dumpster will be located. In accordance with 527 CMR 1.0-1.12.8.5, containers shall not be placed at any location as to become an obstacle to the egress of persons from a building or to vehicle traffic. Any dumpster 6 yards or more needs a permit. A permit is not required for dumpsters that will be delivered and removed from a location on the same business day. Permit is valid for one (1) year from date of issue; permanent dumpster permits are renewable annually.

Procedure:

- 1. Dumpster contractor or customer applies for permit (via OpenGov portal).
- 2. Permit fee \$25.00 per container and \$10.00 for each additional container on a particular site. Payments can be made through OpenGov.

Dumpster location on private property to be inspected by the Worcester Fire Department.
