



CITY OF WORCESTER ENTERTAINMENT APPLICATION GUIDE

All applicants for entertainment licenses shall complete and file with the License Commission the application form(s) designated by the License Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission", as amended from time to time by the Commission, and shall pay such application fee as shall be required by law before any application will be heard by the Commission.

There are two types of entertainment licenses

- Non-Live Entertainment – which includes Radio, TV, Background Music, recorded music
- Live/Non-Live Entertainment combined which includes Radio, TV, Background Music, Recorded music, Dancing by Entertainers, Dancing by Patrons, Bands, DJ, Vocal Music, DJ, Karaoke, Floor show (play, theatrical exhibition, comedian, dance performance, cabaret, jukebox

Non-Live Entertainment applications will be placed on next available License Commission agenda if filed by proper deadline and complete application is filed.

Live/Non-Live Entertainment combined applications will be first reviewed by the Worcester Fire Department and the Chief Building Official who will determine whether the proposed business operation will meet current code and fire requirements. Once these officials have determined that application is completed it will be placed on a License Commission agenda for approval.
