WPS Budget Overview

- WPS operates on a budget of over \$500 million, primarily funded through state Chapter 70 aid and local tax revenue.
- The budget supports salaries, student services, technology, transportation, and infrastructure improvements.
- Balancing financial resources is critical to meeting the needs of over 24,000 students across the district.
- Advocate for increased state and federal funding to support growing student needs.

Policy Work & Curriculum

- School Committee plays a key role in approving curriculum updates and ensuring educational standards are met.
- Recent policy work includes expanding career and technical education (CTE), supporting special education, and enhancing early childhood education.
- Advocating for culturally responsive teaching and curriculum that reflects Worcester's diverse student body.
- Works with district leaders to implement new policies that promote student achievement and well-being.
- CKLA, Math and Science curricula.
- Ongoing policy work around, homework, health and wellness, naming policies and more.

Superintendent Hiring & Oversight

- The School Committee is responsible for hiring, evaluating, and overseeing the Superintendent.
- Works closely with Superintendent Rachel Monarrez to set goals and ensure accountability.
- Provides guidance on district-wide initiatives and long-term planning; including strategic plan.
- Ensures that the Superintendent follows policies that align with state and local education laws.

Working with Constituents and Departments within the System

- Engage with parents, teachers, students, and community members through public forums and meetings.
- Addresses concerns from families regarding school policies, funding, and student services.
- Collaborate with city officials, people within WPS and outside agencies to support the needs of the students staff and families of the WPS.
- Work with the Finance, Operations and Governance subcommittee. to address school operations and policy development.
- Support initiatives that strengthen school-community partnerships, such as after-school programs, mental health resources, and workforce development opportunities.
- ► Follow work that is ongoing in Teaching, Learning and Student Supports(TLSS) in order to provide adequate support.
