

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE PROVING COMPLIANCE WITH WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT

Section 25C of Chapter 152 Massachusetts General Laws requires that every local licensing agency shall withhold the issuance or renewal of a license or permit to operate a business or to construct buildings in the Commonwealth until it has received acceptable evidence of compliance with Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage required by law.

As a person or company seeking a license or permit to operate a business or to construct buildings, or the renewal of such a license of permit, you must supply one of the following by attaching it to the Certificate of Compliance.

IF YOU HAVE EMPLOYEES:

I submit a Certificate of Insurance showing workers' compensation insurance or a copy of a policy of workers' compensation in effect as of the date upon which the issuance of the license or permit is requested.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE EMPLOYEES:

In certain circumstances listed below, workers' compensation insurance is not required. If one of the situations applies to you, please check off the appropriate exemption.

I am a Sole Proprietorship or Partnership and have no employees and do not elect coverage under Regulations set forth in 452 CMR 8.07 (1) to (4).
