PLEASE SEE BELOW GENERAL BID CLARIFICATIONS:

 The Owner will coordinate the testing and removal of all asbestos directly, outside of the construction contract. The Contractor will be required to identify the areas of the building where cutting, coring or disturbance of surfaces are required, such that the abatement can be performed. Such areas shall be identified a minimum of 21calendar days in advance of the date that the Contractor's work is scheduled to be performed.
