## **ADDENDUM NO. 1**

To Whom It May Concern:

With reference to our bid request relative to the above subject, please refer to the changes/modifications/clarifications to the original proposal request.

## • PLEASE SEE BELOW QUESTIONS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES FROM CITY

- 1. Are there any other specifications for this project? All specifications are included in the posted bid specifications and drawings or included by reference in same.
- 2. There are detailed expectations for the securing of the rectangular planters to the concrete; what are the instructions for the *round* planters? The larger round planters are just to be placed and not permanently installed.
- 3. Please clarify that the soil for the planters is exactly the same as the sandy loam mix for the beds. This is detailed in the Technical Notes for Planters item 5 on sheet 5 of the drawings.
- 4. The plans refer to a hardwood mulch for mulching of the beds; hardwood mulch is not typical as an industry standard, instead it is usually spruce, hemlock, pine or a mix of these that is recommended. Should we expect to provide the hardwood mulch? Provide hardwood mulch, as specified in the bid documents.
- 5. Please clarify that the guarantee applies to all plants *other than* the annual plants that are to be planted in the selected round planters. Annual plants cannot be guaranteed for a one year period. Annual plantings are still covered by the guarantee according to their expected life cycle.

Bidders are requested to acknowledge and/or include this addendum with bid. All other terms, conditions and specifications remain unchanged.
