The Worcester Division of Public Health (WDPH) is looking to purchase a GateKeeper field shelter and associated accessories on behalf of the Region 2 Health & Medical Coordinating Coalition.

Scope:

The vendor shall provide per unit pricing on the following products:

- Stretched-Octagon Shelter with rigid-frame, 19'x35'x6' (wall height), for a total of 570 sq. ft. usable floor space. The product should include the Shelter Frame, Roof, Walls, Vinyl Flooring, two 46" Doors, two Threshold Ramps, two 6-Stake Kits, a Vinyl Repair kit, and all necessary Carry Bags.
- An Insulation package product should include Roof and Wall panels with all necessary Storage/carry bags.
- A Lighting system product should be LED, 1200 Lumen, 30.5" All-Weather inline lamp with hanger straps with all necessary storage/carry bag or case. White Lights only.
- Wiring Harness system product should include four sets of 20-amp harnesses, each with three junctions boxes. Harnesses should be able to be plugged together in series or separated to create separate circuits. Each junction box should contain at least two outlets.
- Electrical Distribution Kit 50 Amp, should include 1 ea. 50 Amp distribution panel, 2 ea. 50 amp 50' extension cords, 6 ea. 20 amp 50' extension cords, and a durable storage case.
- Air Plenum System Product should be appropriate to the space and use of the shelter and HVAC system, include 20' ducts, and Hard Start Kit for smaller generator connection.
- HVAC System product should be completely self-contained and portable, provide 42,000Btu/hr of cooling and 40,000 Btu/hr of heating with a supplemental 27,000-36,000 Btu/hr (208-240 volt) heat strip. Product must be UL listed for outdoor use and rated at 208/240V, single-phase power with dimensions of 42"x56"x35". Product must include Intake Boot, Discharge Boot and Duct Boot Bag. Please include full-frame, wheeled transport cart and a vinyl cover. In addition, due to regional weather, in order to support supplemental heat strip below 40-degrees ambient provide an additional 50 amp circuit. Product must connect with HVAC Air Plenum system.
