With reference to our bid request relative to the above subject, please refer to the changes/modifications/clarifications to the original proposal request.

- PLEASE SEE BELOW QUESTIONS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES FROM WPS IN RED:
  - 1) Emergency Services
    - a) Given RFP is from town, we assume we have access and buy-in from their Emergency Services Department? Ultimately, yes buy-in and access as needed, if specific access to department member or department itself, arrangements and meetings can be set up when requested.
    - b) What software do they currently use to manage emergency services? We currently use Pamet Computer-Aided Dispatch software and are in the process of moving to Centralsquare CAD, 18-24 month process. We also utilize CodeRED for emergency and non emergency community notifications and Smart911 within the community.
    - c) Does it allow for custom development through API Pamet does not allow for custom development through API, but we believe Centralsquare does allow this.
    - Does it have any built-in communications abilities (specifically Mobile App PUSH) None at this time



- Can it allow for custom outbound API commands? Inbound? Pamet cannot. Centralsquare might be able to but we do not have firm information on that at this time.
- 2) Does the township (for Emergency Services) maintain any:
- a) Existing messaging gateways? Currently using CodeRED for community notifications (Emergency and Non-Emergency)
- b) Existing voice SBC environment? No.
- 3) Any thoughts on communication beyond the app? Omnichannel alerting? -SMS, WhatsApp, -Voice, -Video We currently accept voice and SMS emergency calls through our 9-1-1 system. Not currently looking to expand into other applications at this time, as we are building out new CAD and extensive training is required for this for the current staff.

Bidders are requested to acknowledge and/or include this addendum with bid. All other terms, conditions and specifications remain unchanged.
