The description on the styling chair is very vague, with quite a few items fitting the descriptions that vary greatly in price/quality. Did the school select any chairs, or have a particular style name/manufacturer they would like. Any images, additional information would be greatly appreciated.

Answer: The chairs that the specifications are modeled after are QSE all-purpose chair and the QSE styling chair *by Collins*. Or equal products are acceptable but must minimum performance standards.

Most states are requiring Nail Tables to be vented 12" from the area that the techs are working from - the Petite Nail table is available with the option to connect to the buildings HVAC Ventilation system (the difference in price is appr \$140 each table.). Just confirming that this is or is not required in your county/state. TY!

Answer: The nail tables need to be vented.

The Spa Treatment Table - what type of base - Fixed, Hydraulic, or Electric.

Answer: Hydraulic
