With reference to our proposal request relative to the above subject, please refer to the changes/modifications/clarifications to the original proposal request.

## PLEASE SEE BELOW QUESTIONS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES FROM CITY:

1. Based on RFP, it identified the criteria with completion date for the report by or about May 1<sup>st</sup> and selection criteria of either May 1<sup>st</sup> (Highly Advantageous), June 1<sup>st</sup> (Advantageous) ,or after June 1<sup>st</sup> (Not Advantageous). With the RFP submittal date being March 20<sup>th</sup> and possibly an interview period, followed by contract execution and data collection which could take months, I don't see how it would be feasible to complete a report by that time frame. Please confirm time and selection criteria associated with that item.

Answer: Comparative Criteria # 6 is revised as follows:
Highly Advantageous – Schedule shows report will be completed by June 1, 2024
Advantageous – Schedule shows report will be completed by July 1, 2024
Non-Advantageous – Schedule shows report will be completed after July 1, 2024 but before September 1, 2024

2. Is the City looking for a Revenue Requirement or Cost of Service study? Each require a different level of effort related to a rate study.

Answer: We are looking for a comprehensive rate study to include revenue requirements and cost of service, resulting in a rate structure options and recommendations.

Proposers are requested to acknowledge and/or include this addendum with submission. All other terms, conditions and specifications remain unchanged.
