- 1. Is there a 5 street limit?

- 3. Who is responsible for Private utility structures that need repairs?
 - The Contractor is responsible to contact the utility company to make needed structure repairs.
- 4. The specs say the prep work to be done by Contractor. Is this correct?
 - Prep work to be completed by contractor. The Engineer will walk every street with the contractor to identify and mark out all necessary repairs.



- 5. Please provide and item for traffic control.
 - Traffic control is incidental to the work. No major traffic control operations are expected under this contract.
- 6. Please provide and item for the portable message sign.
 - Portable message will not be required under this contract unless requested by the Engineer. If requested, it will be billed T&M
- 7. Can concrete collars for adjusted structures be filled level to the existing top course of the road?
 - HMA collars compacted in lifts are called for under this contract and will be paid for under the updated item 424.0000 by the Ton.
- 8. Can the city provide laydown areas?
 - Finding laydown areas are the responsibility of the contractor. If a public road
 or lot is used, the contractor is to take pre-construction photos and videos and
 restore the location to equal to or better condition after construction is
 complete.
- 9. Please confirm the completion date
 - The revised Completion Date is June 30, 2025.
- 10. Who is responsible for fliers and parking sigs
 - Contractor is responsible for fliers and posting no parking signs.
