## PLEASE SEE BELOW QUESTIONS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES FROM CITY

1. Is the intention of the Landing Zone to act as a Disaster Recovery site for on-prem workloads? Will this Landing Zone act as DR site for future cloud workloads?

Answer: Yes, it will act as a Disaster recovery site for on-prem workloads. We will also be doing development within Azure in the future.

- Is the desire to use Azure Site Recovery to orchestrate DR failover?Answer: Yes, we would like to use Azure Site Recovery.
- 3. Is the expectation for the vendor to test Backup/DR from an infrastructure standpoint (ASR orchestration, Azure VMs config, connectivity), and the customer will test at the application level?

Answer: That is correct. The vendor would test from an infrastructure standpoint, and the City of Worcester would test at the application level.
