With reference to our bid request relative to the above subject, please refer to the changes/modifications/clarifications to the original proposal request.

- **PLEASE SEE BELOW QUESTIONS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES FROM CITY:**

- What is acceptable for conduit/ wiremold to conceal wires on concrete walls? Is it acceptable on interior walls/ceilings in offices where there is no drop tile?
 - No concrete walls are within the scope of the project. No conduit or wire molds should be used, all walls and ceilings shall be snaked.

- Are we allowed to cut access panel to snake cabling?
 - Cutting access panels is allowed but prior approval from City is required.

- Who is responsible for patch and paint?
 - Awarded bidder is responsible for patching and painting.

- Who is providing network switches?
 - The city is responsible for any network switches

Bidders are requested to acknowledge and/or include this addendum with submission. All other terms, conditions and specifications remain unchanged.
