Questions Received by this Office and Answers from the City:

1. Item 806.2 2 Inch Electrical Conduit
 - B. Materials - The Standard Specifications call for Rigid Metal Conduit.
*Please confirm that the City desires RM Conduit to be installed under this contract.
 - E. Installation - The Standard Specifications require a minimum of 4 inches of concrete on all sides when crossing streets and driveways. Without any plans to reference, it is not possible to determine how much concrete will be required under this item.
*Please provide a contract bid item for concrete encasement.
A: Item 806.2000 has been removed and replaced with Item 804.2000. The material used is 2" SCH 80 PVC as specified. NO concrete needed for encasement for this item in this contract because road, sidewalks, and driveways will be compacted during construction
2. The above-referenced project lists proposal items 435.1 Random Crack Sealing, and 490 Polymer and Crumb Rubber Modified Sealant. Where does the City propose to use these items on streets that are to be reclaimed?
A: The Crack seal has been narrowed to a single item. It is meant to be used as requested by the engineer at: asphalt joints at the back of driveways and the joints at the limits of paving, and for general crack seal as needed.

Bidders are requested to acknowledge and/or include this addendum with submission. All other terms, conditions and specifications remain unchanged.
