To Whom It May Concern:

With reference to our bid request relative to the above subject, please refer to the changes/modifications/clarifications to the original proposal request.

• Please see below questions received and responses from City

- What training do you require our officers to have?
 A one hour training will be required for all unarmed security guards. Most of the training
 - thereafter is done on the job.

 Do you anticipate situations where our officers will have to go "hands on"? What is the extent
 - of physical involvement?

 Security Guards will need to have the endurance to walk around the school building two or
 - three times a day.
- 3. Why is this contract going out to bid?
 - Contract term is ending.
- 4. Who is currently guarding these locations?

ISSM Protective Services

a. Are you looking to keep current officers?

There are 4 current security guards who might be interested in staying on with the new security vendor. Successful bidder is welcome to contact any existing staff upon award.

b. Are the current officers union affiliated?

No, not union affiliated.

c. What is the seniority date of current officers?

Do not know this information.

5. What happens to the deployment of officers in bad weather, scheduled closures (i.e. summer)?

Officers do not work during non-school days including vacation and snow days



- 6. What is the expectation of the degree of involvement from supervisors?

 Supervisors would choose their own method of supervising the security guards.
 - a. How often would a supervisor be required to visit the officers? Supervisors should visit their employees at least bi-weekly(check-in)
 - 7. To what extent will officers need to be involved in Title IX issues?

 Security Guards are required to report any negative behaviors/actions of students/staff/outsiders in the building.If it involves a potential Title IX violation, the school administration would take the lead on investigation and follow-up...
 - 8. Will officers be required to participate in training that other staff members at the school locations are to be involved in?
 - Security Guards will be involved in some staff meetings if the Principal deems it appropriate. Security Guards working in administration buildings would not be involved in any training.
 - a. Who will be required to pay for the training? School District would pay for any training.
 - 9. What are the types of communication equipment the officers will be required to use?
 All Security Guards will be provided a Walkie-Talkie in order to communicate with staff.
 Equipment paid for by the School District
 - 10. Are there any wage rate requirements (prevailing wage, union, etc.)
 - 11. Do you wish to retain current Officers
 - There are 4 current security guards who might be interested in staying on with the new security vendor. Successful bidder is welcome to contact any existing staff upon award.
 - 12. How is meal relief currently handled?All security guards are entitled to a lunch break and other breaks when needed.
 - 13. Do you have any pto or vacation requirements for Officers?

 No, there are no District requirements. Vendors must comply with state labor laws.
 - 14. Do you have any specific training requirements?

 There will be a one hour training for every security guard prior to working at their respective school or administration building. This training can happen with everyone in one meeting.
