To Whom It May Concern:

With reference to our bid request relative to the above subject, please refer to the changes/modifications/clarifications to the original proposal request.

• **PLEASE SEE BELOW QUESTIONS RECEIVED AND RESPONSES FROM CITY**

Question: I had another question regarding the approved disposal site (Wheelabrator in Millbury, MA). According to their website and confirmed by a representative at WinWaste, they do not accept propane tanks, TVs, electronics, appliances, mattresses, box springs, furniture, etc. They do not accept these items because they are included in the MADEP waste ban. They only accept Category 1 & 3 C/D, bricks, asphalt, metal and OCC. Since they do not accept these items, what would be the correct course of action by the awarded contractor? Would it be to dispose of them ourselves at a different approved transfer/recycling station?

Answer: Bidders are advised that they may dispose of any and all debris at the facility of their choice in a legally responsible manner. Bidders are NOT required to use Wheelabrator in Millbury, MA.

The City, however, will not allow for payment for distances longer than fifteen miles outside of the City limits. The hourly rate charge for hauling debris cannot exceed 20 minutes (1/3 of an hour).

Bidders are requested to acknowledge and/or include this addendum with submission. All other terms, conditions, and specifications remain unchanged.
