Can you provide the part numbers for oil filters, fuel filters, air filter and transmission filter?

A: Here is a list of filters we use.
7746xd oil, 600123 oil, 3812 and 3118 both fuel filters, P560971 trans filter kit,
1970,1971 oil, 4112 coolant.

Most vehicles have fluid capacity plaques on the drivers door skin; Ex. of one tag...

Engine oil 39qts
Engine coolant 80qts
Trans 44qts
Power steering 9.8 qts
Transfer Case 3-4 qts

Some variations in fleet whereas we have 2 cat c13s, multiple Detroit 60s, a 6v92 a bunch of X11s and the X12s are most abundant.

All vehicles are running Allison 3000 4000 transmissions.
