The City of Worcester, Department of Transportation and Mobility is seeking bids for the purpose of disposing scrap metals generated by the On & Off-Street Parking Program. The metal is being stored at the Union Station Garage (225 Franklin St) and the Worcester Common Underground Garage (3 Eaton Place). The successful bidder will pick up all metal within 15 days of being awarded the bid.

1. **ALL ITEMS ARE OFFERED FOR SALE “AS IS WHERE IS”. THE DESCRIPTION IS BASED ON THE BEST AVAILABLE INFORMATION BUT THE CITY MAKES NO WARRANTY, GUARANTY, OR REPRESENTATION, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED AS TO QUALITY, QUANTITY, KIND, CHARACTER, WEIGHT, SIZE OR DESCRIPTION OF THE ITEMS.**
2. **CONDITIONAL BIDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**




