CITY OF WORCESTER DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND PARKS RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PROVIDING OF SNOW PLOWING SERVICE

The City of Worcester (hereinafter "City"), through its Department of Public Works and Parks, has established these Rules and Regulations for the providing of snow plowing services by independent contractors (hereinafter "Contractor").

- 1. The Contractor will provide snowplowing services under the direction of the City.
- 2. The Contractor will provide a copy of current MA commercial, owner-contractor, or snow removal registration(s). Plates from other states will not be accepted.
- 3. The Contractor will provide a registered vehicle, fuel, a licensed operator, and snow plowing equipment in accordance with the minimum blade requirements listed on page one. The Contractor shall equip his/her vehicle with Emergency Equipment as specified by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the vehicle must have working safety lighting in conformity with Massachusetts DOT regulations.
- 4. Upon request by the City's Department of Public Works and Parks, the Contractor's vehicle shall report equipped with tire chains in the vehicle or installed when requested by the inspector.
- 5. The Contractor's name is required on all vehicles at all times of operation, and the signage is subject to DPW&P approval. Letters shall be a minimum of 3" in height and in a color that contrasts the background. Vehicles with a GVW of 18,000 lbs or greater must also display vehicle gross weight, tare and net weights.
- 6. The Contractor will provide a certificate of liability insurance made out to the City. The terms of the insurance shall be as follows:
 - ❖ Automobile Liability of \$100,000/\$300,000 minimum
 - ❖ Property Damage of \$50,000 minimum
 - ❖ Workers Compensation (if applicable) as required by Massachusetts General Laws.
- 7. The Contractor shall file a written report with the City's Department of Public Works and Parks for any known accident or property damage that occurs during the providing of snow plowing services. Said written report shall be submitted within forty-eight hours of the incident and include the date, time, type of accident or damage, other party involved (if applicable), location and any other pertinent information.
- 8. The Contractor, his agents and employees must cooperate with the City and claimants in the investigation of claims made against the City for property damage or personal injury alleged to have occurred during snow plowing operations.

- 9. Twenty-three and one-half (23.5) hours shall be the maximum chargeable time in any 24-hour period. A 30-minute unpaid break will apply to shifts between 12.5 and 24 hours long. The next 30-minute unpaid break will apply to events between 24.5 and 48 hours.
- 10. The hourly rate for plowing service is attached hereto as "Exhibit I" and incorporated herein. The hourly rate shall apply to all equipment with no premium for nights, Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays.
- 11. When plow or sanding services are required to report prior to December 1st or after March 31st, a \$10.00 per hour bonus shall be paid in addition to the rate listed in Exhibit I. This stipend is to be paid only for equipment reporting to winter storms occurring before the first of December and on or after the first of April.
- 12. The City will pay one (1) hour reporting charge to allow time for plow hook-up, loading of ballast and other vehicle preparation provided the vehicle reports to the assigned plow route station within two (2) hours of being called. If the vehicle reports after 2 hours of being called, the vehicle will be paid from the reporting time.
- 13. The Contractor's service shall be required for a minimum of four (4) hours for any one storm event. When the period of work exceeds four (4) hours, the Contractor shall be paid for the actual duration of time worked, the time to be computed to the hours and minutes.
- 14. The Contractor shall provide with this application two (2) photographs, one side-view and one-rear view, of each piece of equipment to be used.
- 15. The City presumes you will adhere to all applicable Department of Transportation regulations with respect to drug and alcohol testing for CDL license holders.
- 16. The Contractor shall possess a cell phone at all times of operation and provide the phone number to the City.
- 17. Only plow blades with steel cutting edges are acceptable. Snowplow shoes must be removed when plowing. Contractor equipment with rubber cutting edges will not be allowed to work.
- 18. The City reserves the right to inspect any vehicle at 29 Albany Street at any time during winter operations.
- 19. The City reserves the right to inspect any operator's license of any operator plowing for the City.
- 20. Failure to comply with these Rules and Regulations for the providing of snow plowing service may result in a suspension of payment and/or termination of service.
- 21. The City will pay a \$1000 perfect attendance bonus for each piece of equipment that reports every event that it is called for plowing meeting the following requirements: the piece is registered, insured, and has applied before December 1st, the piece reports within 2 hours of being called every event between December 1st and April 1st, and it plows a minimum of 4 hours each event without a breakdown. The City will not pay a perfect attendance bonus for sanding or salting. A \$2000 perfect attendance bonus shall apply to backhoes, loaders, and graders.

Following these points will assist in providing this community with the snow plowing services they expect and should receive from all of us. Thank you for your assistance and cooperation.

DO:

- Arrive as soon as possible after being called and check in with your inspector
- Arrive fully fueled
- Make sure vehicle is properly signed
- Plow all streets curb to curb unless otherwise instructed
- Plow the gutters first, especially during larger or intense storms
- Plow away from legally parked cars when possible
- Plow in tandem with other equipment when possible

DO NOT:

- Arrive late
- Pile snow on intersection corners, crosswalks, bus stops, parked cars, or hydrants
- Plow in driveways on cul-de-sacs or dead-end streets
- Plow on private property
- Plow down the center of roads repeatedly without plowing the gutters
- Leave your route for any reason without checking with your inspector
