**EVERYTHING IS RECORDED AND READY!  
HOW DO I DECIDE WHERE TO PUT MY SOUND EFFECTS?**

**1** To get organized, make a radio script!

**2** Find these 3 places in your story:

- ✓ Introductions to new people or places
- ✓ A moment when something important or dramatic happens
- ✓ A transition in the story, like moving between speakers

**3** Ask yourself if a sound effect would sound good there or be distracting. You're in charge!

**4** See if you can find the sound for free online or record it yourself!

**5** Edit your sounds in an editing software. You can download Audacity for free on a computer by [CLICKING HERE](#). You can use TwistedWave online by [CLICKING HERE](#).

#### Example Radio Script

Time	Audio Clip Name	Content
0:00 - 0:30	Music 1	Happy mood intro music
0:30 - 1:30	My Narration	Introduce grandmother and explain what we will be talking about
1:30 - 2:30	Interview with grandmother	She answers questions about her childhood
2:15- 2:19	Door Slamming Sound	Use at moment she talks about door slamming
2:30- 3:00	My Narration 2	Explain what I learned from interview
2:45- 3:00	Music 2	Grandmother's favorite song
